IURC Authority



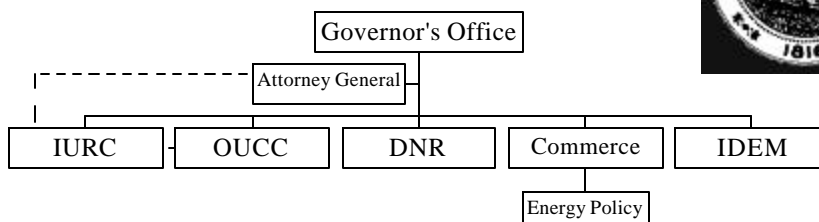
- Information Collection

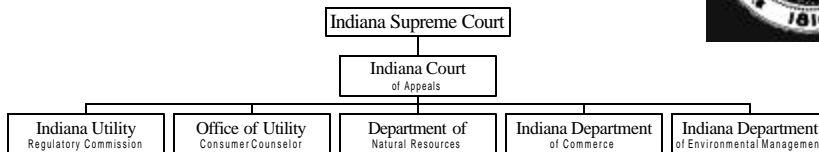
Executive Branch

- When Requested, State Administrative Agency Decisions and Orders, Including Those of the IURC, May Be Appealed to the Indiana Court of Appeals
 - Court of Appeals Decisions May Be Transferred to the Indiana Supreme Court For Further Review

- Information to Legislators
 - Analysis of major issues
 - Report to a specific Joint Committee
 - Importance of relationship
 - Response to constituents of elected officials
 - Requests and complaints
